


Dear Year 3 Parents,

Hope you are well. You will be glad to know that children are now well settled in their new year group and are working hard. Thank you very much for your help and support.

Here are some clarifications and reminders:

Book Bags/ plastic zip bags/ plastic Wallets:



As you know your child needs to bring in school their reading books, reading records, their homework books as well as their spelling books. From my teaching experience I know that if they bring these items from their backpacks in the cloakroom to upstairs in the classroom, some will lose few things on the way. So it is much easier to have a book bag or a zip bag to keep their books in.

They are allowed backpacks (instead of book bags). They just need to make sure they bring all of their books as well as their snacks and water bottle, from their back packs in the cloak rooms to the class room and remember to take everything at home time.

Homework:

If they struggle with their homework, please remind them that we will go over the problems on Friday afternoons. Please make sure they do their homework neatly using a pencil and encourage them to join their letters.

Reading Records and Book Change:

Our book change day is Thursday. That's the day we also check their reading records, to make sure they are reading regularly at home. But that's not the only day we change books. If they finish their book before Thursday, then they can put their books with their reading records in the brown box and we will change those for them. Mrs Gayer checks the brown box every day after our Guided Reading session.
